## SCHOOL STAFF CARPARK

We thank you all for your support in this important matter. Helping us to achieve our aim of keeping pedestrians and cars separate in an accident free zone. Pedestrians please use footpaths at all times.

Please remember for the benefit of us all:

- ◆ Staff car park for staff only and other authorised users
- ◆ Mornings is a one way single file drop off and go system only, stop at last cone-no waiting. Please exit vehicle on left side i.e. along side railway line.
- ◆ If you need to park, use the streets where permitted giving consideration to others and home owners. The yellow line operates between 8:15-9:15 and 3pm-4pm. Both sides of George street outside the school gate, again no waiting during these periods
- ◆ There is no parking outside the office at any time even to drop off.
- ◆ **After school please be aware of where and how you park on the streets. Recent incidents that have been shared with the police from neighbours CTV show that some people are not being considerate when parking and also sometimes dangerous.**



### REMINDERS:

- Always enter school via the Reception area and not through the cloakrooms.
- PE kits to be in school on the right day for your child's PE lesson. Due to limited space in the cloakrooms we ask that the school PE bags are used not the larger fashionable ones
- Plain stud earrings are allowed, children must be able to remove their own earrings for P.E.
- ALL uniform/equipment should be clearly labelled with your child's name. Please help your child look after their belongings.
- Please do not leave your children unattended at the school gates before 8.30am
- Apart from KS1 parents, please wait at the main gate for all other pupils to avoid congestion.

Please ensure your child 's uniform complies with our uniform policy. A copy is available from the office or on the website
